
Fork Guard (FG-1) Installation for: Ducati Multistrada 620/1000/1100

OFF-ROAD USE ONLY

- 1. Remove the stock front fender using an M4 hex wrench. Set the fender, screws, and small plastic washers aside; you won't need them.
- 2. Note that the FG-1 is shipped with two "dogbone" shaped aluminum shims. They're a little over 2" in length. Refer to the drawing below for their placement:



- 3. Put a small amount of blue thread locker onto (2) of the included M6x16 bolts, put them through the FG-1 first, then the dogbone shim, then into the fork leg. Note that the bolts go into the fork leg from the back side of the fork now.
- 4. Tighten the bolts to 10-15NM (do not over-tighten!)
- 5. Check to make sure there is at least 0.188" (5mm) clearance between the FG-1 and the upper fork leg. You may adjust the clearance simply by grasping the FG-1 and slightly bending it in or out.
